Begin our journey to Gros Morne mountain, spectacular views of Ten Mile Pond gulch and ferry gulch embraces us on the journeys end.

Hike down from the plateau through Ferry Gulch, enjoying the views of Bonne Bay and the Gulf of St. Lawrence.

Hike to the parking lot where we are transported to a warm cozy cabin, and hot shower and a good home cooked meal.

Day 7

Today we explore the south end of Gros Morne, the Tablelands and beautiful Green Gardens, weather dependent.

Enjoy sea-stacks, sea-caves and coastal hike of the sea-shore.

Day 8
