

Day 1

Arrive in St. John's. Transferred from airport to accommodations, and then we welcome you with a traditional Newfoundland feast. This is where everyone gets to meet each other on the tour. There will be 2 guides that will guide you through the tour, and feel free to ask them as many questions as you wish.

Day 2

Today we discover St. John's. We visit the most easterly point in all of North America, beautiful Cape Spear. Also we will be looking at other points of interest such as the Cabot Tower. After lunch we take a boat tour visiting Humpback Whales and Ice Bergs (optional activities available)

Transport Time: 2hrs

Day 3

Enjoy hundreds of bird colonies today. Puffins, Gannets and Gull nest along the cliffs that plunge into the ocean.

Transport Time: 1hr

Day 4

Begin the morning, head to Terra Nova National Park today to complete a day hike. Watch for Moose, Woodland Caribou, and Black Bear throughout the trails. This is a moderate hike and other options will be available for clients not wanting to take part in the hike.

Transport Time: 2hrs

Day 5

Continuing our journey across the island we travel to Nore Dame Bay, a beautiful area frequently visited by Humpback whales and Icebergs. Today is Mostly just a travel day with rest stops along the way. Arrive in Gros Morne National Park

Transport Time: 6hrs

Day 6

(8:00am) Begin our morning with a healthy breakfast in the beautiful town of Woody Point. Travel to discovery centre (1/2 hour). Then begin our hike of the big lookout. The lookout has a great panoramic view of the park and the world famous tablelands. Also take in the tablelands on our way to Trout River.

Lunch

Complete a hike of Green Gardens, beautiful sea-stacks rise all along the shoreline, and sea-caves to explore. (Optional Boat Tour Available) After completing the hike, eat at a great sea-side restaurant and have dinner watching the sun set on the Atlantic Ocean. Travel to back to accommodations. (Woody Point) (8:00pm)

Day 7

(7:30) Eat breakfast and complete a hike of beautiful Stuckless Pond. Begin our drive to the south end of the park. Stop and each lunch at a picnic area. Continue our drive to the town of Rocky Harbour and complete an evening hike of Bakers Brook Falls. Evening campfire on the sea-shore. Head for a evening dinner at a beautiful restaurant.

Travel to accommodations for the night (Rocky Harbour)

Day 8

(8:00am) Take a beautiful boat tour of the famous Western Brook Pond, a 800m glacier carved fiord. Explore waterfalls that fall 400m into the fjord. Evening Sea-Kayaking tour with optional hikes. View Exhibits and Fishing communities along the Coastline. (Broom Point, and Shallow Bay)

Day 9

Today we climb Gros Morne Mountain, 805m above sea-level. This hike is strenuous and is approx. 7 hours to complete. The view is absolutely breath taking.

Day 10

Today we head north to Port Aux Choix, completing a hike along the sea-shore. View the history and artifacts of the archeological dig.

Lunch at picnic area.

Keep heading north to the town of St. Anthony where we stay the night.

Day 11

Travel to L'anse aux Meadows, to the old Viking settlement over 1000 years old. View small coastal communities, living in one of the harshest environments on earth. Begin our travel to Main River where we spend the evening and night at Tuckamore Lodge nestled in the heartland wilderness on Newfoundland.

Day 12

Begin our travel back up the Northern Peninsula to Deer Lake for your last day. A few small day hike along the way

Lunch at Rocky Harbour.

Clients should note, flights should be booked flying into St. John's on the first day and departing Deer Lake on the Last day.
